

Thankful to be your pastor.



Last November our church came together and donated shoe boxes for children in another country for Christmas (or what Operation Christmas Child calls Gospel Opportunities). 81 boxes were donated and we reached 81 kids with the gospel of Christ, gave 81 kids the opportunity to be discipled in their new Christian walk, and showed 81 kids that the physical love of God can reach thousands of miles right to where they are and that they are not alone in this world—that there is someone who loved God and loved them enough to send them that gift.
