


Weekly Meetings Begin

August 3rd-5th For 9th-12th Grade Boys

When does a boy become a man? Is it when he can vote? When he has facial hair? When he gets married or has kids? Or is manhood something that can be taught? These few days we will be doing some primitive camping at night and completing some tough challenges during the day. Most importantly, we will be searching God's Word on what true manhood is. Jesus spent 33 years on this earth being an example on how to be true men. We will explore basic foundations of authentic manhood, God's clear design for men, and discover a clear definition of Authentic Manhood.

Homebound Visits


