

Please sign up and select your appointment time as soon as possible. The registration table is open immediately following both morning worship services.








### SOFTBALL SIGN UP

Our youth fundraiser meals will begin February 3rd at 5:30 p.m. Funds raised will help with the summer youth missions programs. As always the cost will be by donation.


