
Our DO SOMETHING Camp is July 17-23!




Celebrate summer with this tasty dessert pizza, using your favorite summer fruits as the toppings.

What you need:

- 1 tube slice-and-bake sugar cookie dough
- Knife
- Round pizza pan
- 8 ounces cream cheese
- ¹/₃ cup sugar
- ½ teaspoon vanilla
- 2 cups sliced fruit
- Adult help

What you do:

- 1. Cut the dough into slices ¹/₈-inch thick. Place slices on the pan, overlapping them slightly.
- 2. Bake at 375 degrees for 12 minutes. Let cool.
- 3. Combine softened cream cheese, sugar and vanilla, mixing well. Spread this "frosting" over the baked-cookie "crust."
- 4. Arrange fruit on top of the pizza.
- 5. Slice and enjoy!


We will observe the ordinance of The Lord's Supper Sunday, July 10th during the evening service. Be reminded that a benevolence offering is taken up at this time.
