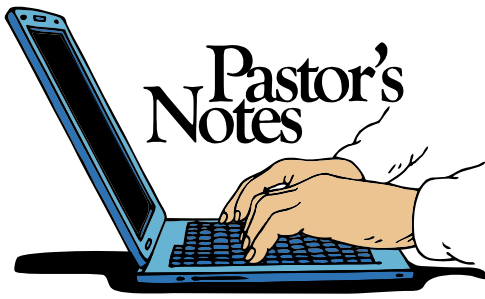

## Pray for America

On June 16th, during the evening prayer session of the Southern Baptist Convention annual meeting, Rev. Ronnie Floyd, president of the SBC, called for messengers to pray for America and for Southern Baptists to model "true unity that's only really found" in the gospel.

Floyd said, "The only thing that can reshape America is the next spiritual awakening and the next move of God. When you look at it historically, there is no great movement of God that is not first preceded by the extraordinary prayer of God's people. What is extraordinary prayer? It is praying beyond the ordinary."

In a call to pray specifically for racial reconciliation, pastors of differing races came together onstage. Floyd said, "Pray for America, a country that is broken, fragile, divided, where racism and prejudice is ruling. We will lead the way, modeling true unity that's really only found in the redemption of Jesus Christ. Let's pray for our country to come together." Let's join him in this Prayer: *"Lord, hear our prayer for our country, in the name of Jesus hear our prayer for our nation—that our nation will come together and we as the church of Jesus will be the hope for cities, towns, and relationships. It is only possible because of your redemptive work. It's only found in Christ."*



As we celebrate our nation's independence and freedom on July 4th let us celebrate even a greater independence and freedom found in Jesus Christ. Because of the finished work of Christ on the cross we have been set free from the bondage of sin and are no

longer slaves to the flesh and to the devil. There is nothing greater than independence and freedom found in salvation.

Speaking of celebrating, we need to celebrate a wonderful Vacation Bible School. We had close to 40 decisions made during VBS and many of those decisions were first time professions of faith.

We also celebrate the opportunity we had to attend the Men's GridIron Conference in Birmingham. Men, the conference was such a blessing and I encourage all men to sign up for next year's conference.

We celebrate what God is doing with our new building as well as celebrate what God is doing inside the hearts of our church members. Revival is bursting forth and we give God all the honor and glory and wait anxiously for each Sunday to see what He is going to do.

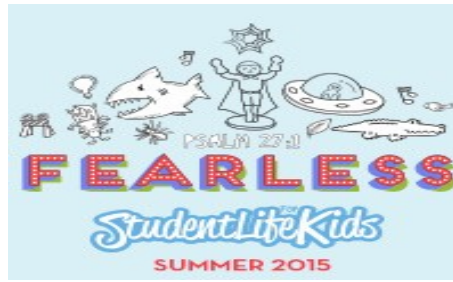

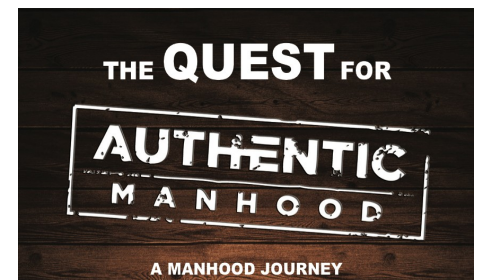

## Happy sunshine cupcakes

Psalm 144:15 says, "Blessed [or happy] are the people whose God is the LORD." Make these bright cupcakes to remember all the ways God makes you happy.



### **What you need:**

- Adult help
- Cake mix
- Cupcake liners
- White frosting
- Yellow food coloring
- Black frosting or tube gel
- Candy corn

### **What you do:**

1. Make cupcakes by following directions on the box. Let them cool completely.
2. Stir yellow food coloring into white frosting, making it as yellow as the sun. Frost the cupcakes.
3. Using black frosting, make a happy face on each cupcake.
4. Around each cupcake, place candy corn with points out to resemble sun rays. Enjoy!

You might want to vary this idea by using red & blue with the white icing for patriotic cupcakes. Use red twizzlers and loosen the strands on one end to look like a firecracker. Dip the ends in colored sugar and stick in icing on top of cupcake. You could also use sugar stars confetti.
