






PUZZLE

We have no record books for our church prior to 1913. It is known that Pilgrim Rest messengers attended the 1890 Pensacola-Bay Baptist Associational Meeting. Included in the report of this meeting was this information regarding our church. W. F. Martin was pastor, T. J. Helton (should be Hilton) was clerk and the membership was reported as 25. We contributed \$1.25 for the Associational Minutes and \$1.75 for the Associational Missions. -Your History Committee
