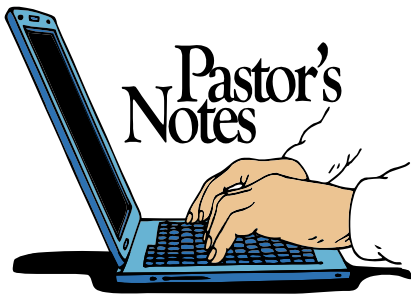
FAMILY FUN

Praise the Lord! I am so glad at how well Homecoming and Building Dedication went this past Sunday. I have been asked by many people about the future plans concerning our church services as to whether we are going to stay with two services or consolidate to one service. After much prayer,

consulting with church growth experts, and consulting with other church staff I am pleased to announce we will remain at two services. We are doing this for a couple of reasons. First, is our parking situation. We do not have enough parking to accommodate a maximum capacity in our attendance. Parking currently is structured to handle approximately 400-450 people. If you were here for Homecoming you noticed our parking situation and that was with 508 in attendance. We do not have adequate parking to have everyone on campus at the same time and still have room to grow. Second, by having two services our church has more opportunity to reach people for Christ. There are some people in our community who can only attend an early service due to their job and/or family situations. Not to mention with two services we have the opportunity to have more people in attendance at church. With our current numbers if we were to only have one service we would already be between 70-75% capacity and when a church hits 70% they typically stop growing. Third, we currently have over 100 people attending the early service and it could be very disruptive to uproot them from that service. Fortunately, we do have more space overall and we invite you to attend whichever service that works better for you. Please continue to pray for the staff and leadership as we continue to seek God's will in this and all church matters.

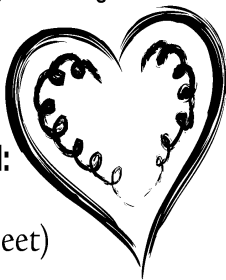

A heartfelt felt heart

What you need:

- Red felt (8" x 11" sheet)
- Dark pen
- Fabric scissors
- Pillow stuffing
- Straight pins
- Embroidery thread (pink, red or black)
- Needle
- An adult to help

What you do:

1. Fold the felt in half and draw a heart on it. Cut out the heart so you have two of the same size.
2. Place the hearts on top of each other, add stuffing and pin the hearts together.
3. Thread the needle with a long piece of thread. Knot the end.
4. Sew the hearts together. Knot the thread and trim the ends. Remove pins.
5. Give the gift — and a hug!

~To Qualify: You must be 6 years of age or older, no dental insurance coverage, and your family must be at or below 200% poverty guideline.

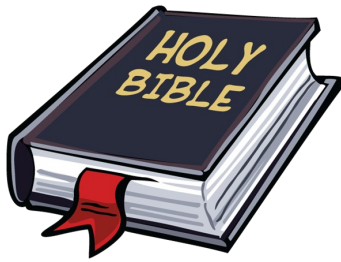

We will be starting a new Men's Bible Study in May. We will meet in the Fellowship Hall at 6:30 p.m. every Monday night, except May 30th.

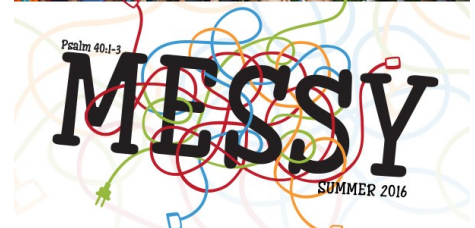
