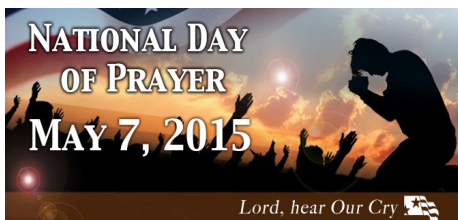
A WORD FROM THE PASTOR

May's Theme is:

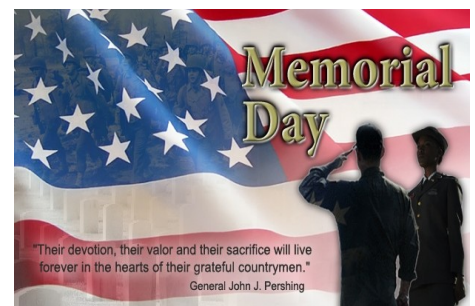
HONESTY . . . choosing to be truthful in whatever you say and do.

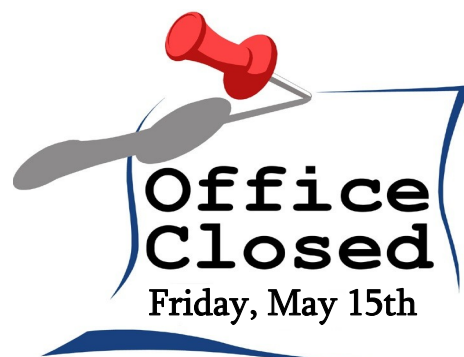
