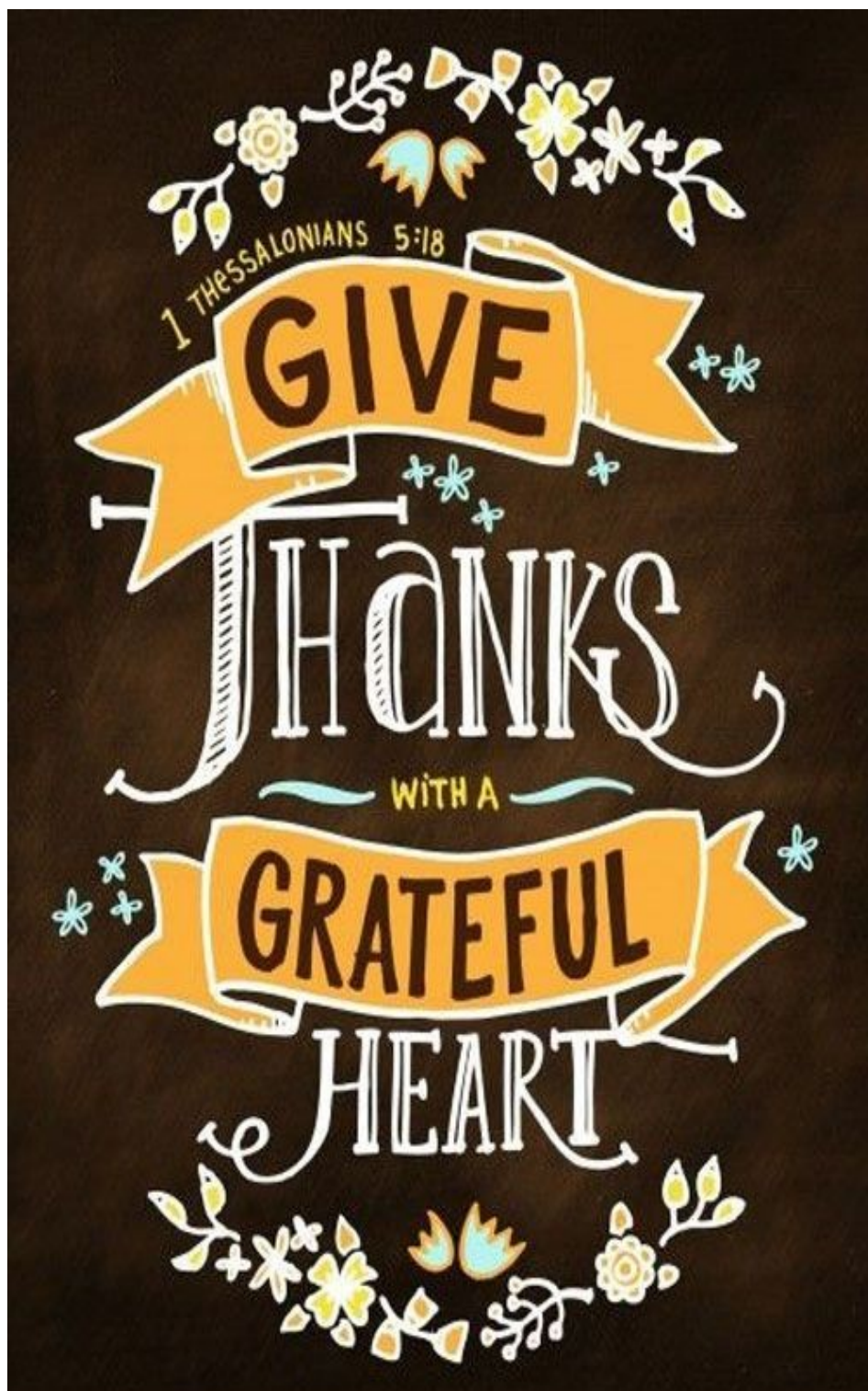

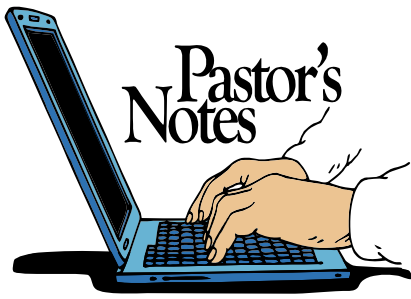

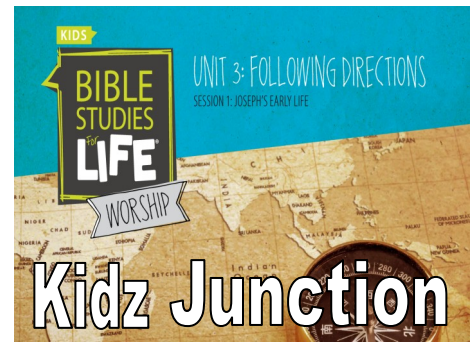


**National Collection Week:

## Early Church History Tidbits

In 1888, Brother Wiley Martin and Brother Holley conducted a protracted meeting (in the little schoolhouse) and at this time Brother Peter Griffith suggested the organization of the church. Two names were presented and Brother Wiley Martin chose Pilgrim Rest. He was the first pastor. The charter members, who came from Milligan Church, were Mr. and Mrs. Bud Bush, Mr. and Mrs. J.R. Henderson (Elizabeth Catherine Morrison), Tommie Hilton, Frances (Black) Hilton and her mother, Mrs. Black, Mrs. Hattie Bryars, Hallie Stewart, Mr. and Mrs. Peter Griffith (Jane Nichols), Peney Griffith (daughter of Peter), Lizzie Garrett, Cena (aka Sena Griffith) Livingston, Jackson Griffith (son of Peter) and Oliver Norris.

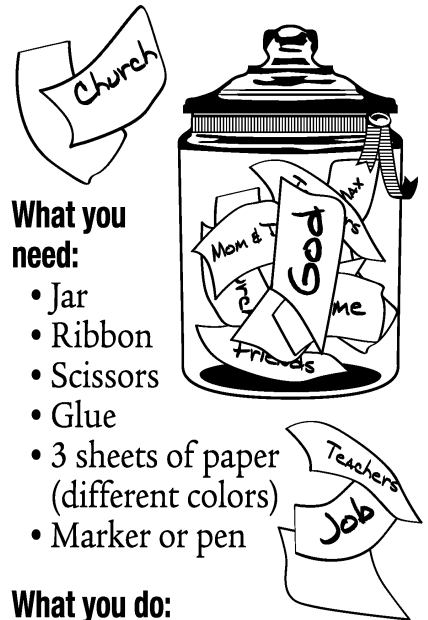

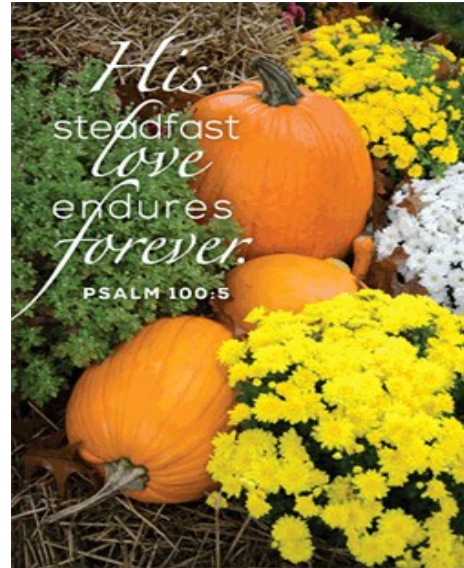

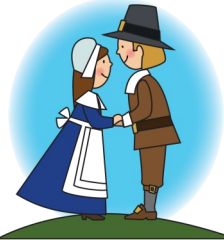
