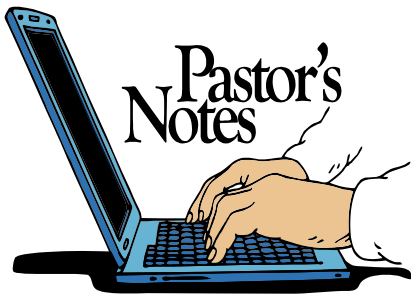

people to accept Christ and inviting people to attend church with us.

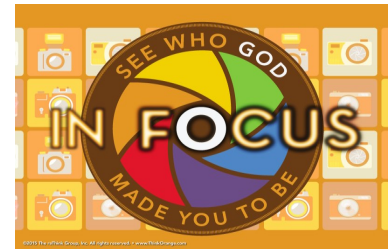

Starbucks Pumpkin Scones Copycat Recipe

(Yield 8 scones)

Ingredients:

2 C. all-purpose flour
1/3 C. brown sugar, packed
1 tsp. cinnamon
1 tsp. baking powder
3/4 tsp. ground cloves
1/2 tsp. ground ginger
1/2 tsp. ground nutmeg
1/2 tsp. baking soda
1/4 tsp. salt
1/2 C. (1 stick) unsalted butter,
cut into cubes
1/2 C. pumpkin puree
3 Tbsp. milk
1 large egg
2 tsp. vanilla extract

Glaze:

1 C. confectioners' sugar
2 Tbsp. milk

Spiced Glaze:

1 C. confectioners' sugar
1/4 tsp. cinnamon
1/4 tsp. ground cloves
1/4 tsp. ground ginger
Pinch of nutmeg
2 Tbsp. milk

Instructions:

- Preheat oven to 400° F. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper or a silicone baking mat; set aside.
- In large bowl combine flour, sugar, cinnamon, baking powder, cloves, ginger, nutmeg, baking soda and salt. Add cold butter, using your fingers to work the butter into the dry ingredients until it resembles coarse crumbs.
- In large glass measuring cup or another bowl, whisk together pumpkin puree, milk, egg and vanilla. Pour mixture over dry ingredients and stir using a rubber spatula until a soft dough forms.
- Working on a lightly floured surface, knead the dough 3-4 times until it comes together. Using a rolling pin, roll the dough into a 10-by 7-inch rectangle, about 1-inch thick. Using a large knife or a pizza cutter, cut the rectangle in half lengthwise, then cut into 2 even pieces crosswise, making four rectangles. Then cut each rectangle into two triangles, making 8 triangles.
- Place scones onto prepared baking sheet. Place into oven and bake for 10-12 minutes, or until a tester inserted in the center comes out clean.
- To make the glaze, combine confectioners' sugar and milk. Whisk until smooth. If the glaze is too thick, add more milk as needed; set aside. To make the spiced glaze, combine confectioners' sugar, spices and milk. Whisk until smooth; set aside.
- When the scones are done, cool for 10 minutes and spoon the glaze on each scone. Let that glaze firm up a little before drizzling with spiced glaze.
- Allow glazes to set before serving.

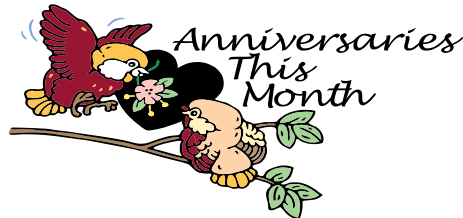
