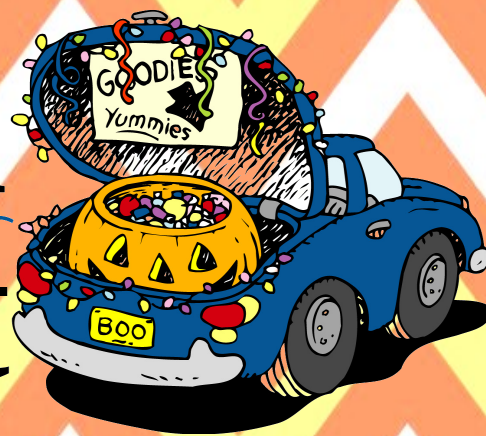

Trunk or Treat

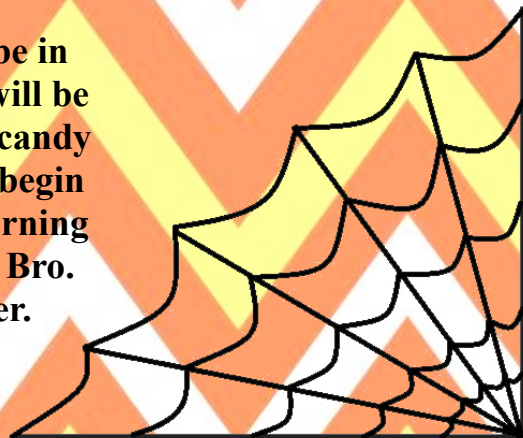


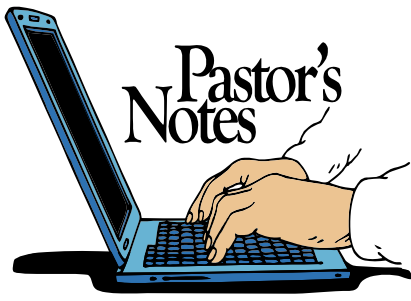
Sunday, October 30th
