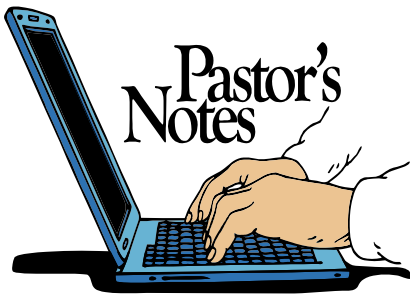

Happy October Pilgrim Rest Church Family. I pray this article finds you doing well. I am so excited to see what God is doing at our church and excited to give you an update on our ALL IN Capital Campaign. As most of you should know, the first Sunday in September we kicked off our ALL IN Capital Campaign to help pay off the

new worship center. We mailed letters to all church members and regular attendees explaining the need, the reason behind the campaign, and asked everyone to prayerfully consider what God would have them give. As with any church giving, especially a Capital Campaign the idea is not equal giving but equal sacrifice. So many of you have faithfully sacrificed for years in order for the building to become a reality and I want to say thank you. For those who have not yet had the opportunity to give in this area, now is your opportunity to join with the rest of your church family and let's get this building paid off. As of today we have received 31 pledge cards totaling 104,393.88 pledged over the next 3 years for the ALL IN campaign. If you have not turned in a pledge card it's not too late. You can either place it in the offering plate or mail it to the church office. One final note, many of you have asked why? Why must we do a pledge card? The simple answer is this: We need the cards for two reasons. First, if and when we refinance with the bank we need to show repayment potential, and the other reason is for basic budgeting purposes for our finance team so they can properly budget during the next 3 years. 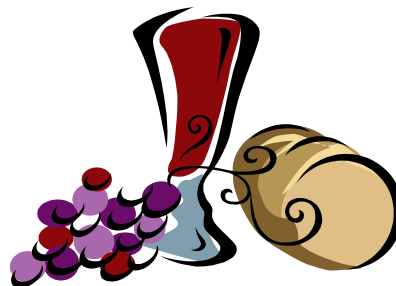
