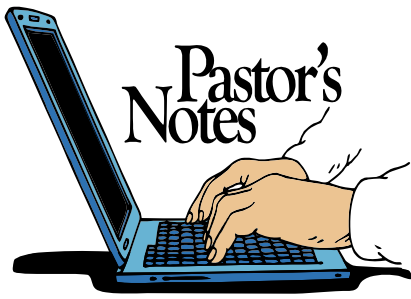


Senior Adult Activities

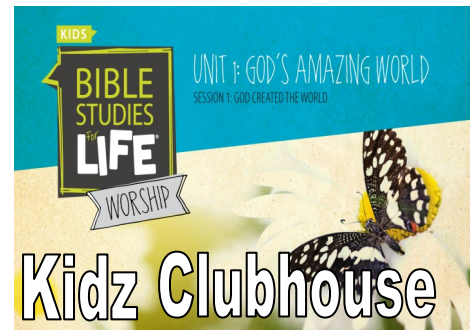
As always, I covet your prayers. Pray for each other, our community, and our nation.

Early History Tidbits of Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church

In 1883, Lewis McGraw taught school in a rustic little log school house built by William Henderson, Tommie Hilton, J. R. Henderson, J. L. Miller, W. S. Henderson and Austin Griffith. It was nestled in a cove of trees at the foot of a hill on the east side of where the building completed in 1978 sits. A group of people began meeting in the log school building for church services. Bro. McGraw would teach school during the week and preach on Sundays. Bro. Wiley Martin would preach occasionally, so would Nick Baggett and John Mapoles. (Excerpt from personal handwriting of Exie Henderson Stanley, granddaughter of William Henderson and Mary Jane Wilkinson.)

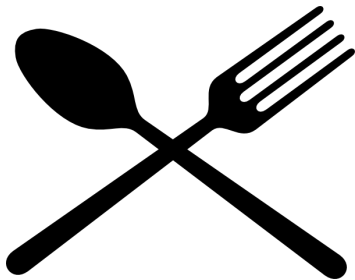
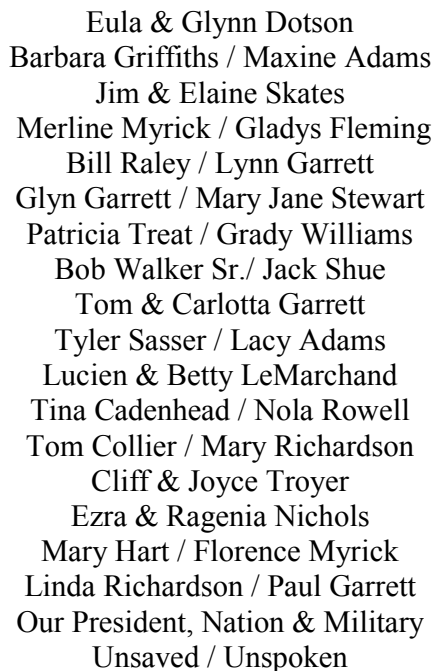
Good News Club

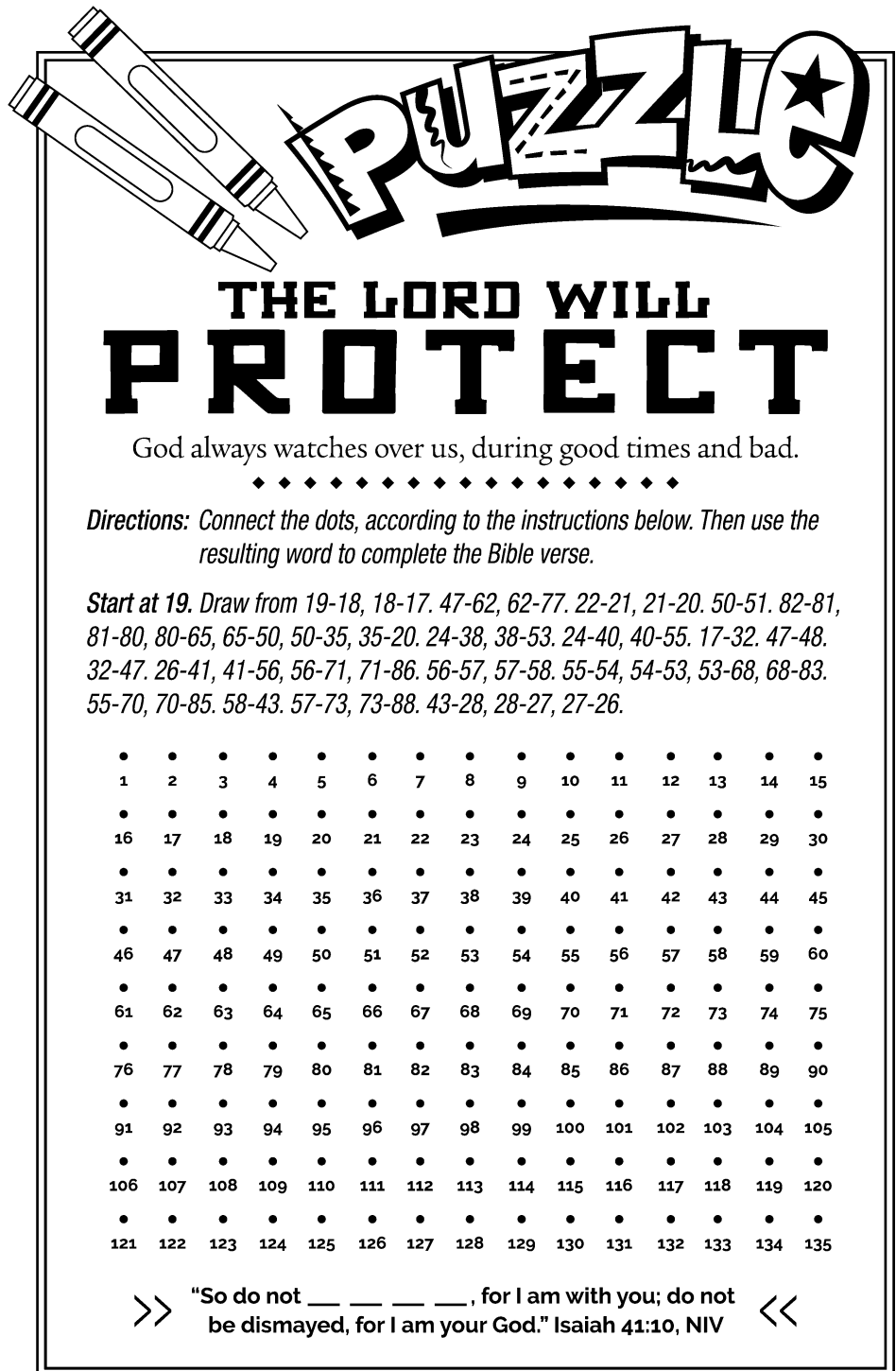


Mattress Fundraiser
