2017 LOTTIE MOON CHRISTMAS OFFERING®




Nation Goal: \$160 Million Church Goal: \$5,000 Prayerfully consider what your part will be.

After more than a century, the annual offering continues its steady growth. The National Goal this year is \$160 Million. Your giving enables missionaries to be sent to make disciples and multiply churches among unreached peoples and places for the glory of God. Last year alone, IMB (International Missions Board) missionaries saw 87,000 people from all over the world come to know Christ. Also in 2016, IMB missionaries helped to plant more than 4,500 churches where there had previously been none.
