Did you know that the average church member in an American church now attends church just 2 Sundays per month which equals basically attending 24 hours for the entire year? Let that never be said of us.

2.COMMIT TO FINDING A PLACE TO SERVE

There is an old saying when it comes to people serving at their church; “Twenty percent of the people do eighty percent of the work.” Could you imagine what a church could accomplish if 50, 60 or 70 percent of the people were serving. Better yet, could you imagine what a church could accomplish if everyone found a place to serve?

3.COMMIT TO TELLING OTHERS ABOUT JESUS

There are many people in our community without a personal relationship with Christ. Will you commit to sharing your faith with at least one of them during 2019?

4.COMMIT TO GIVING Giving back to the Lord is Biblical.

Part of God’s financial plan for each of His children is that we faithfully give back to Him. When we give back we are acknowledging God’s goodness and blessings in our life. Giving also requires a step of faith. When we give back we are saying that we trust God to do more than we ever could. If you currently do not give I encourage you to take that step of faith. If you currently give I want to say thank you, but also challenge you to commit to giving more than ever before. Maybe for you—commit to one extra weeks tithe. For others of you commit to one extra months tithe, and for others it may be even more.

5. COMMIT TO PRAYING and GETTING IN THE WORD

Prayer and Bible reading is one of the most neglected spiritual Disciplines. I challenge each of you to spend time daily in the Word and praying. The psalmist declared in Psalm 119:97. “Oh how I love your law! It is my meditation all the day.” May you fall in love with God’s Word during 2019.

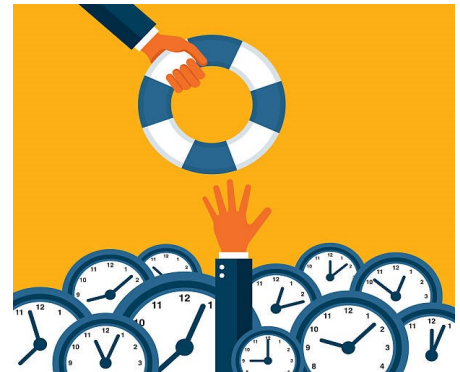

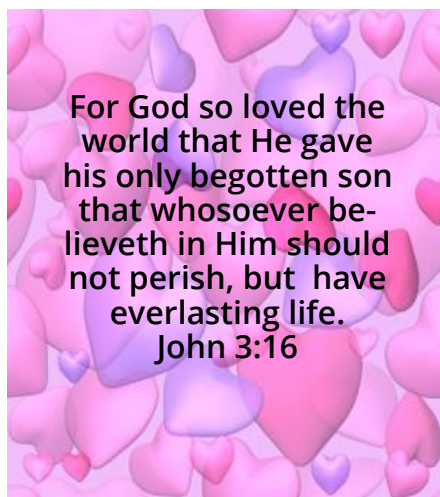
