Wow! Wow! Wow! That is all I can say when it comes to what God did at PRBC during the month of April. We saw a half dozen people saved, we had our first 32531 outreach, we celebrated a \$122,000 Joash offering, we had over 200 names turned in on "Who is Your One Sunday", and to top it off we had 621 in attendance at Easter. If that doesn't excite you I am not sure what will.

Even though we saw some great success in April I am more excited about May. On May 5th we will have our baptisms at the beach. Once again the event will take place at Henderson Beach State Park at 6pm. Come join us for this exciting time of worship and baptism celebration.

Something you will hear more about in May is the opportunity to purchase 9 acres of the large field next to the church. This is an exciting opportunity that can open the door for so much at PRBC. Currently we are landlocked with no room to grow because any new building construction that takes place would require additional paved parking for which we have little to no room. The 9 acres will allow us to do multiple things. First, it will allow us at some point in the future to build a family life center and/or fellowship hall combination. Everyone who has ever stepped inside our fellowship hall knows it is too small to currently meet our church needs. Second, the church owning the 9 acres will allow the cemetery to expand. Currently there is a small parcel of land right behind our cemetery which at this time cannot be utilized by the cemetery because it is the only land left where we could put ANY additional paved parking that could be required by the county if the church were to expand. It would be nice for the cemetery to be able to expand. Third, the additional land will allow the church to do the unknown. We know what we can do at this moment as well as what we cannot do due to space and land restrictions. It is exciting to think about what God can do in the future that is beyond anything we can imagine. Our church has existed for 131 years and I am excited as to what the next 131 may look like.

Many of you may already be asking, "How are we going to buy the land?" At this point we are not that far along in the process. We have simply been offered the opportunity to purchase it. The full church body will have to approve everything before we ever get to the point of actually purchasing the land. I am simply making everyone aware of the possibility that is before us. What I am asking each of you is this, pray! Pray that God will give the building committee direction. Pray that God will provide the finances needed if and when the time comes. Pray that God will make His will abundantly clear and we as a church will follow obediently.

It truly is an exciting time at PRBC. I want to encourage each of you to remain faithful in your weekly attendance, in your giving, in your evangelism, and in your zeal for the Lord Jesus. As always, I covet your prayers.

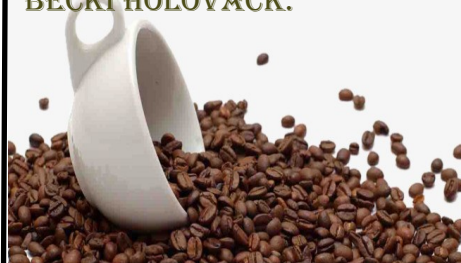

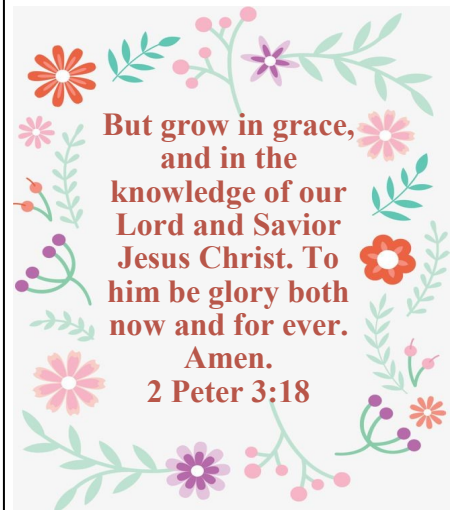

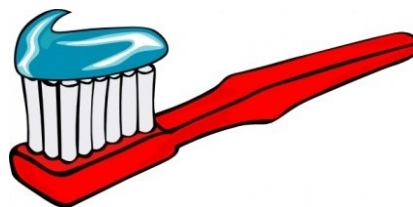
