




HISTORY COMMITTEE

In 1888, a group of people living in and around Cobb (early Baker name) in Santa Rosa County, now Okaloosa County, met in a log cabin school house with no pastor and about 20 members: Black 1, Garrett 3, Hilton 2, Griffith 4, Henderson 7, Livingston 1, Norris 1, Stewart 1

In 1889, according to Pensacola Bay Baptist **Assoc. minutes Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church** was officially organized. In 1894, Mr. & Mrs. Joseph Olinger donated 2 acres of land to the church. The deed is recorded November 29, 1904 in Santa Rosa County and Okaloosa County formed later. Around 1900, the congregation erected a wooden building. In 1915, the church purchased the church bell for \$15.00 from Laurel Hill Baptist and currently used today. In 1916, a storm blew the building off its foundation blocks and strained the budget and members had to make repairs. Since money was scarce the church had difficulty paying the pastor's salary and he often received payment in forms of produce & livestock.




