For two years, I have been praying for God to send revival; not revival meetings but true genuine revival. Dr. Mac Brunson in a recent sermon made the statement that no one alive today has seen true, genuine, honest revival. There have been two great revivals throughout modern church history but wouldn't it be amazing to see one more. I believe God desires to send revival but do we really want it. Will we do what it takes to have revival? It is obvious our nation, state, community and even our church needs it. We need God. The average weekly giving amount per churchgoer is \$17 per week which amounts to \$73.67 or roughly \$884 per year. Approximately only 5% of church goers actually tithe, actually give 10% of their income. Could you imagine what God would do with and through a church where the masses of people tithe? Giving is a heart and faith issue not a dollar and cents issue. God tells us to test Him in this area, to try Him and see if He will not pour out his blessings on the generous and faithful tither. Giving is part of our worship because we do not give to a church, we give to GOD. May God do a work in us when it comes to giving.

The average churchgoer attends church 1.6 times per month whereas 15 years ago that number was almost 3 times per week. Many Christians are forsaking the assembling together and replacing it for the non-eternal, for things that will not last in the end. Parent, I beg you to get your entire family into church weekly because there is a 100% chance you and your children will stand before God one day and I want your entire family ready for that day. I promise you, your children will have a far better chance of making a God connection at church. As WA Criswell preached a famous sermon entitled "The Old Time Religion" I do long in a sense we get back some things that American Christianity has lost, but in reality for many what they have lost is their first love. They do not love Jesus like they once did.

As I pray for revival, I am so thankful for how God is at work. Over the last 6 weeks we have welcomed 29 new members into our church with many of them coming via Believers Baptism. The satellite church plant continues to progress and I am happy to tell you that the work has now been fully funded for the first two years. Many of you may not be aware but that work will require NO funding from PRBC. Valley Road Baptist sold their old parsonage and all the proceeds from the sale of the home along with money already with VRBC and monies given by the Florida Baptist Convention will FULLY fund the work for the first two years if not longer. Also, there may still be some confusion as to whether the satellite work will be a separate church, the answer is NO. We are ONE church, TWO locations. God is at work at PRBC and let's celebrate How he is working.

As always I covet your prayers and am grateful to serve as your pastor.




